We are to seek God's will for our lives

God's will is not always simple and apparent

- Genesis 3:6 Hebrews 5:14 Proverbs 14:12 Acts 15:36-40 Why?
- 1. God is more concerned about relationship than activity
- 2. Carrying out God's will requires prayer and His presence

General will of God for your life

- John 6:40 1 Thessalonians 4:3 1 Thessalonians 5:18
- Loving Jesus, Loving People, Transforming Lives

Specific will of God for your life (Progressive will)

How do we know what God's will is?

Romans 12:1-2

1. Surrender

- Luke 22:42
- "I seek at the beginning to get my heart into such a state that it has no will of its own in regard to a given matter. Ninetenths of the trouble with people is just here. Nine-tenths of the difficulties are overcome when our hearts are ready to do the Lord's Will, whatever it may be. When one is truly in this state, it is usually but a little way to the knowledge of what His will is." - George Müller

"All that we are, all that we have, all our desires, plans, affections, choices, likes and dislikes must be fully surrendered to God in utter submission before we can know what His will is... Choose to do God's will for your life instead of your own will. Do not launch out upon the sea of life headed for a port of your own choosing, guided by a chart of your own drafting, driven by the power of your own selfish pleasures or ambitions. Come to God, yield your life to Him by one act of trustful, irrevocable surrender. So shall you come steadily to know and see God's will for your life." – Dr. Leon Vanrooyen
