What is Worship?

The Greek word for "worship"

- to kiss, to fall down, to bow down before and give reverence"

The Hebrew word for "worship"

- "to fall or to lay face down before someone on the ground, touching your forehead to the earth"

The English word "worship"

- "to ascribe worth or value to something."

Webster's Dictionary, 1828 - Worship is to honor with extravagant love and extreme submission

Everyone is a worshipper – we were created to worship.

- "Show me where you spend your time, money and energy and I'll tell you what you worship." - John Wimber
- Only Jesus truly satisfies: John 6:35 John 14:6 Psalm 16:11

Worship – Ascribes worth to God

- Psalm 66:1-2 Nehemiah 9:5-6 Psalm 29:1-2
- The fuel of worship - John 4:23 Psalm 71:8
